

OUR COVID-19 SAFETY PROTOCOL

As a healthcare organization, the health of our patients, doctor, and staff is our top priority as we service your needs. As a result, we wanted to take the time to remind you of the precautions we are taking to ensure our community is safe.

What We Ask of You:

- If you are exhibiting signs of COVID-19 or if you believe you have been in contact with someone who may have been exposed, we ask you to reschedule your exam.
- Please come to your appointment by yourself or limit who comes with you to one person so we can adhere to CDC social distancing guidelines.
- Please wear a mask.
- If you need someone to bring you to your appointment, we ask that they wait outside or in their vehicle.
- Upon your arrival, we ask that you wait outside and we will call you when ready for your appointment.
- Even if you do not need to see the doctor, we ask that you make an appointment.

What We are Doing to Ensure Your Safety:

Limiting the Number of Patients

- We will be actively limiting the number of patients and exams to adhere to CDC social distancing guidelines.

Temperature Check Upon Arrival

- We will utilize a contactless thermometer to take temperatures of everyone who enters the location and will ask anyone with a fever to reschedule.

Protective Equipment & Cleaning Supplies

- Masks and gloves have been secured for our doctor and staff.
- Patients will be supplied with a pair of gloves.
- Disinfectant wipes are available as well.

Frame Selection Safety

- We will disinfect all frames in our new UV sanitizer.

Cleanings of Equipment and Surfaces

- All equipment and surfaces will be cleaned after each exam.
- Exam room will be disinfected with UV sanitizing light after each patient.
- Exam room is equipped with two HEPA air purifiers.
- Patients will be able to sanitize their cell phones and/or eyeglasses in our UV sanitizer.

Social Distancing

- We ask staff and patients to observe 6-foot social distancing whenever possible.

We will continue to monitor CDC guidelines and make changes as appropriate to ensure the safety of the entire community.
